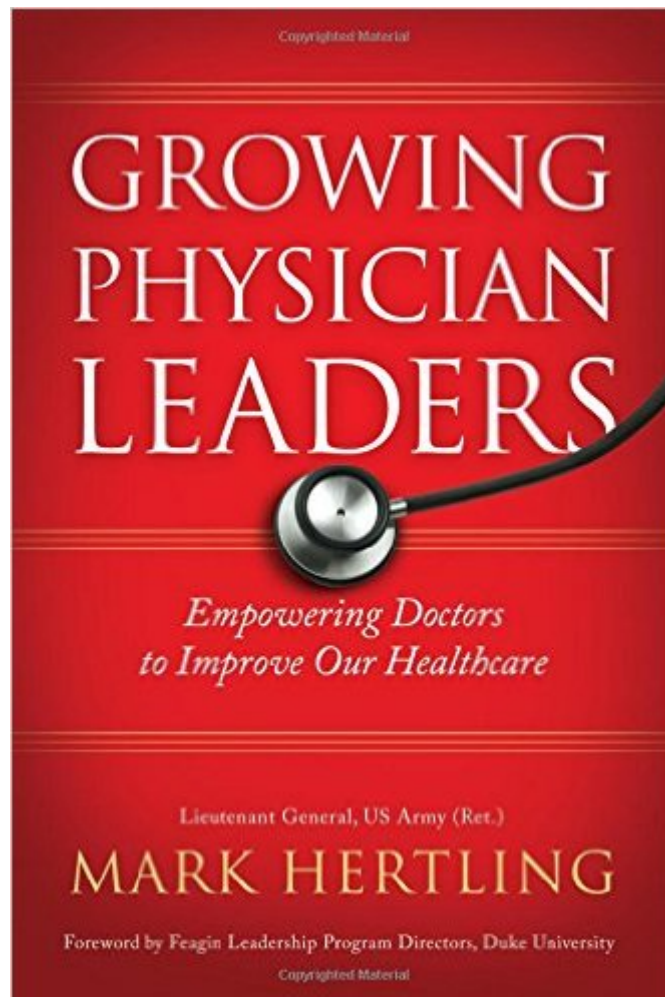

As an emergency medicine physician, I've been trained how to resuscitate the dead, alleviate suffering and treat a wide range of afflictions of the human body. But, my residency and fellowship never taught how to lead and influence people. The military taught me that. So it came as no surprise to me that a retired 3-star General from the U.S. Army, General Hertling, wrote a primer for

physicians looking to take on the challenges of the current healthcare crisis. His book *Growing Physician Leaders* asserts that physicians equipped with the necessary tools of leadership can and will help us address the problems we face today. The Affordable Care Act and ICD-10 are recent examples of how dynamic and frustrating the medical landscape has become. The talks around the cooler for many physicians today focus on an unhealthy work/life balance, diminishing reimbursements, and trying to meet the demands of the paper pushers and bean counters that are now running the show. An interesting study published in the journal *Social Science and Medicine* in 2011 by Dr. Amanda Goodall found that hospitals that are run by physician CEOs rank about 25% higher on the U.S. News and World Report's *Best Hospital List* than those run by non-physicians. With increasing demands for patient satisfaction and quality care, the physician leader is perhaps best positioned to lead an organization that requires both clinical experience and insight into the inner workings of a hospital. So, why then have physicians not been given a seat at the table when clearly they have so much to offer? General Hertling addresses this very issue in his book. There is a natural rift that has developed between administrators and physicians.
