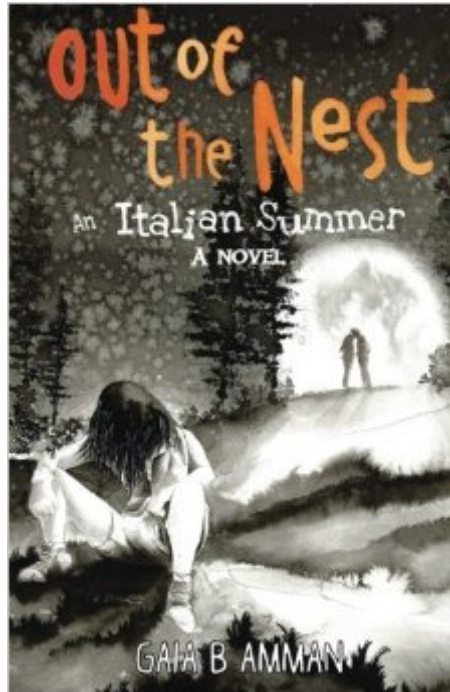


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Out Of The Nest, An Italian Summer (The Italian Saga) (Volume 2)
